Chairwoman Long commented that commissioners wanted to put a hold on finding a location until other vacancies are filled and to research recreational assets in their area of representation. Chairwoman Long inquired as to what the commission wanted to do in regards to the vacancies. The Clerk to Council reported that the vacancies were advertised and the deadline to submit an application would be January 28, 2021. Also, since the Recreation staff is to provide needed information to the commission. The Chairwoman wanted to know if the Recreation Director's position was vacant. Training will be scheduled for the commissioners.

Chairwoman Long restated that the request for the information of the CPST collections from the administrator to see what amount is available for the Recreation Project, an update on the vacancy of the recreation director's position, copies of policies and a special meeting on February 9, 2021 to review applications for two new members.
